Flourishing Neighborhood Index 2025 Assessment

What's This About?

We're looking for friendly neighborhood residents to join us as Neighborhood Surveyors for the 2025 Flourishing Neighborhood Index (FNI). As a surveyor, you'll chat with your neighbors to gather info that helps us understand how our community is doing—think well-being, connection, and overall quality of life.

About the Flourishing Neighborhood Index

The FNI is a tool that helps us understand how residents feel about our neighborhood, looking at things like safety, health, job opportunities, neighbor-to-neighbor relationships, housing, parks, and streets. The 2025 survey results will help residents and community partners make plans for the future.

What You'll Do as a Surveyor

- Talk to neighbors using a set of standard survey questions
- Help people write or select their answers to the survey questions
- Build trust with folks to get them excited about sharing their thoughts
- Meet with neighbors in convenient locations (i.e. front porches, parks, Waterloo Public Library, possibly churches or local businesses offices)
- Keep all the info you collect private and secure
- Join a required training session and weekly surveyor team meetings as available (Zoom or in-person)
- Let us know if you notice any big community trends or concerns while you're out there
- Complete surveys on time

What We're Looking For in a Surveyor

- You've lived in the neighborhood for at least 6 months
- You're great at talking to people and making them feel comfortable
- You're comfortable using technology to log survey answers online
- You can get around the neighborhood (by foot, bike, or car)
- You're fluent in English (it's great if you speak other languages common in the area, too!)
- You have no current plans to leave the neighborhood
- A high school diploma or equivalent is preferred, but not required

Time Commitment

• Part-time, flexible hours (about 5-10 hours a week)

- Runs for 6-8 weeks (July-August 2025)
- One mandatory training session (date TBD)
- Short 30-minute team catch-ups each week (probably Mondays, Zoom or In-Person)

Pay & Perks

- \$25 for each survey completed through online portal
- \$15 for each survey completed on paper and turned in
- \$100 bonus for finishing training
- \$15 bonus for attending weekly team meetings
- Extra bonuses if you go above and beyond your survey goals
